Instructions

1. This is a PDF fillable form. It can be filled out directly in Adobe Acrobat Reader and printed or it can be printed out and hand filled. Either way, it must be printed and signed prior to submission.
2. The cost of joining packages and National dues for all initial unit members must accompany this application. Joining package prices payable once, at joining. National dues is renewable annually and may be adjusted from time to time in accordance with the Constitution.
3. If a member leaves, all patches and badges remain their property since they have paid for them. However, the right to continue to wear the CVFR main patch is revoked. If a member decides that they do not wish to retain the patch, units should consider buying it back from them for re-use if it is in good condition.
4. Unit dues are the responsibility of the unit.
5. Units must have a minimum of two executives : a President and a Sergeant at Arms. If the size of a unit warrants it, consideration should be given to having a Road Captain as well.
6. Units must have a set of by-laws detailing the governance of their unit. These by-laws are to be submitted to the National Executive for approval prior to a unit being approved to stand up.
7. Upon final approval, units will be issued a warrant from the National Executive authorizing them to operate. Until this warrant is issued, the unit has no authority to operate as a CVFR unit. Furthermore, the warrant may be revoked if the unit is found to be in contravention of the CVFR Constitution.
8. This completed form must be accompanied by completed individual membership applications for each initial member, all applicable joining package payments and National dues for each initial member and a proposed set of unit by-laws for review and approval by the National Executive.
